T20 WORLD CUP

Kohli, Suryakumar named in 'Most Valued Team' of 2022 T20

Hardik Pandya named the 12th man of the side

MELBOURNE: Tournament's leading run-getter Virat Kohli and Suryakumar Yadav were on Monday named in the "Most Valuable Team" of ICC 2022 T20 World Cup.

Indian superstar Kohli ended as the tournament's most prolific batter with 296 runs at a stunning average of 98.66.

Kohli kick-started his campaign with a pivotal 82 not out against arch rivals Pakistan to anchor his side to a heart-thumping final-ball four-wicket victory.

And further knocks of 64 not out against Bangladesh, 62 not out against the Netherlands and 50 against England in the semi-finals helped round off an individual competition to savour for one of the greatest white-ball batters of the modern era.

Fellow Indian Suryakumar finished as the tournament's third highest run-scorer with 239 runs overall. Three half centuries -- 51 not out against the Netherlands in Sydney, 68 against South Africa in Perth and 61 not out off just 25 balls against Zimbabwe in Melbourne -- helped haul his side into the semi-finals as he scored at a staggering strike rate of 189.68 in his six innings.

Another Indian, Hardik Pandya was named as the 12th man of the side.

"Players from six different teams have been named in the Upstox Most Valuable Team of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2022," the ICC said in a statement a day after England won

their second world title in the shortest format.

Captain, wicketkeeper and opening batter Jos Buttler, fellow opener Alex Hales and seamer Sam Curran all made the cut for England.

New Zealand star Glenn Phillips and Zimbabwe ace Sikandar Raza occupy the No.5 and 6 positions in the playing eleven. Phillips' stunning century against Sri Lanka catapulted his team to a comfortable 65-run victory in Sydney. Another innings of 62 against England helped him reach a total of 201 runs at an average of 40.20.

For Raza, 219 runs and 10 wickets, proved pivotal assets for Zimbabwe with both bat

and ball. He scored a polished 82 off his 48 balls in his country's opening game against Ireland in Hobart, before further battling contributions against Scotland, Netherlands and India -- bolstered by a brilliant three for 25 as Zimbabwe stunned Pakistan in Perth -- rounded off a tournament to remember.

Completing the middle order is Pakistan all-rounder Shadab Khan, who grabbed an impressive 11 wickets at an average of just 15.00.

And he was similarly impressive with the bat, striking a solid 92 runs at an average of 24.50 to help fire his side to the final in Melbourne.

Sam Curran and Anrich Nortje line up at No.8 and 9,

with the former being crowned Player of the Tournament after a series of spellbinding bowling displays. The left-arm seamer claimed remarkable figures of 3 for 12 off his four overs in the final after getting his tournament underway with a similarly scintillating five for 10 against Afghanistan.

Another bowler who starred was pace ace Nortje, who functioned as a vital weapon in South Africa's armoury after finishing with a tournament-best average of just 8.54. Nortje conceded just 94 runs while in the process of taking his 11 wickets as four scalps against both Bangladesh and Pakistan helped him become one of the competi-

tion's most fearsome bowlers.

Rounding off the side at No.10 and 11 are fellow pace bowlers Mark Wood and Shaheen Shah Afridi, who took nine and 11 wickets respectively for England and Pakistan.

Despite being ruled out of the semi-finals and final through injury, Wood's consistency throughout the Super 12s -- spearheaded by three wickets against Afghanistan and Ireland -- saw him finish the tournament with an average of just 12.00.

And for Afridi, who also suffered an unfortunate injury in Sunday's final, his figures of four for 22 against Bangladesh and three for 14 against South Africa helped him emulate his new-ball heroics in last year's tournament as Pakistan were narrowly denied in Melbourne.

Taking his place as 12th man is Indian all-rounder Hardik Pandya, who starred with both bat and ball by racking up 128 runs and eight wickets.

The dangerous middle-order ace blasted 63 against England in the semi-finals after also took key wickets against Pakistan, Bangladesh and Zimbabwe throughout the

Anil Kumble calls for teams in Test, white-ball cricket

England's roaring success in ODIs, T20s has ignited the debate for different teams and coaches

NEW DELHI: Former India captain and coach Anil Kumble feels having totally different squads in limited overs and Test format is the way forward for the country in international cricket.

England's roaring success in ODIs and T20s has ignited the debate for different teams and coaches in white and red ball cricket.

"Definitely, you need separate teams. You need, certainly, T20 specialists. I think what this English team has shown and even the last (T20) World Cup champions Australia have shown is that you need to invest in a lot of all-rounders. Look at the batting order," Kumble told ESPNcricinfo.

"Today Liam Livingstone is batting at No. 7. No other team has a No. 7 of the quality of Livingstone. (Marcus Stoinis walks in at No. 6 (for Australia).

That's the kind of team you have to build. That's something that you need to invest in.

"I'm not really sure whether you need a different captain or a different coach. It all depends on what team you are going to pick and then choose how you want to build the support and the leadership around it."

Former Australia all-rounder Tom Moody said splitting coaches should be seriously considered by inter-

national teams. England have Brendon McCullum as their Test coach and Matthew Mott as their white-ball coach.

"I think there is no doubt that moving forward, whether it be player or support management, there needs to be a serious look into that separation.

"It seems England have quite a considerable difference between their red-ball squad and their white-ball squad. They've created a depth of quality," Moody told the cricket website after England won their second T20 World Cup title. "With regards to England being the best white-ball team (of all time), I don't think they're there yet. If they had won in the UAE at the last T20 World Cup, you could base an argument, but they weren't there in that one. So they've missed a World Cup there. They've missed that sort of dominance of a cycle."

Moody said the demands on the players and the team management involved in all the formats are huge. "The price of having success is extremely draining. If you are going to be prepared properly, it's very hard to manage it with three formats," said Moody. AGENCIES

Lovlina elated to win Asian gold; says it will help her regain form

NEW DELHI: Star Indian boxer Lovlina Borgohain on Monday said the Asian Championship gold medal is "extremely significant" as she claimed it during her first tournament in a new weight category and it will play a "decisive role" to regain her lost form.

Lovlina has been struggling with form since she won the Olympic bronze medal in Tokyo last year. She changed her weight category from 69 kg to 75 kg keeping in mind the Paris Olympics as her division does not feature among the six categories announced for women's boxing. Last week, the 25-year-old from Assam produced a determined show to clinch the gold medal in her maiden appearance in the middleweight division at the

Championships in Amman, Jordan.

"This gold means a lot to me. It's very significant. This is a confidence booster," Lovlina told PTI after she returned to the country along with the boxing contingent on Monday.

"This was my first championship in a new weight category and I won a gold. So I know that I am in the right direction.

"I had a very good run in the championship and was at ease with my punches and movement. I am regaining form and expecting to peak at the right time. These wins matter a lot."

Borgohain, who also has two Asian Championships bronze medals, said she will try to improve further and hoped

to win the gold medal at next year's World Championships, which will be held in India. "Well, I have won a bronze medal in Olympics last year. I am trying to do well in every championship.

My immediate target is to win a gold medal in next year's World Championship to be held in New Delhi.

"Off course my ultimate aim is to win a gold at the Paris Olympics. I am striving and working hard to achieve that. I hope my best comes out at the right time," she said.

India won 12 medals -- four gold, two silver and six bronze in the championship. Interestingly, all the four gold medals were won by women boxers. AGENCIES

Mary Kom, Sindhu, Mirabai, Keshavan elected in IOA Athletes' Commission

NEW DELHI: Five-time world champion boxer M C Mary Kom, double Olympic medalist PV Sindhu and multiple-time winter Olympian Shiva Keshavan were among 10 eminent sportspersons elected unopposed as members of the IOA Athletes Commission in the polls held here on Monday.

The other seven members of the apex body are Tokyo Olympics silver medalist weightlifter Mirabai Chanu, 2012 Olympics bronze winner shooter Gagan Narang, veteran table tennis player Achanta Sharath Kamal, ace hockey player Rani Rampal, fencer Bhavani Devi, rower Bajrang Lal and former shot putter OP Karhana.

All the 10 members, out of which five are female, are Olympians. Keshavan is the only Winter Olympian.

Only 10 candidates filed nominations for the same number of seats in the Athletes Commission and Umesh Sinha, who is also the returning officer of the upcoming IOA elections, declared all of them elected unopposed.

India's first individual Olympic gold medalist shooter Abhinav Bindra and former India hockey team cap-

Under the new constitution of the Indian Olympic Association which was adopted on November 10, the athletes commission is to have equal representation of male and female members

tain Sardar Singh will complete the 12-member athletes commission in their capacity as members of the corresponding bodies of the International Olympic Committee and Olympic Council of Asia respectively. Both of them will have voting rights.

Bindra was appointed as member of IOC Athletes Commission in 2018 for a eight-year term while Sardar was made OCA Athletes Committee member in 2019 for a four-year term. Under the new constitution of the Indian Olympic Association which was adopted on November 10, the athletes

commission is to have equal representation of male and female members. Keshavan, who has represented India in six Winter Olympics, said this was the first full fledged athletes commission in IOA history.

"Yes, this is a historic moment for the athletes of the country. We now have a proper and full fledged athletes commission for the first time in IOA history," Keshavan told PTI.

Two members of the athlete commission -- one male and one female -- will sit at the IOA General Assembly with voting rights as well as the IOA Executive Council (with voting rights). IOA Executive Council elections will be held on the December 10 on the orders of the Supreme Court.

"We will have our first meeting on Tuesday, we will get to know who will be the president and vice president (one of the two will be a female) tomorrow."

The members of the IOA Athletes Commission were to be elected by their peers and Keshavan said the electoral college was made up of 70-odd members. AGENCIES

हजार से ज्यादा लोगों को लगाया करोड़ों को चूना पैन इंडिया ओला स्कूटी स्कैम में 20 गिरफ्तार

आउटर नॉर्थ डिस्ट्रिक्ट पुलिस ने पैन इंडिया ओला स्कूटी के नाम पर करोड़ों के घोटाले में पुलिस ने 20 लोगों को गिरफ्तार करने का दावा किया है।

इन सभी जालसाजों को बेंगलूरु, गुरुग्राम और पटना में छापेमारी के बाद पकड़ा गया। आरोपी अब तक एक हजार से ज्यादा लोगों को ठगी का शिकार बना चुके थे। इनमें 2 कर्नाटक, 4 तेलंगाना, 3 झारखंड और 11 बिहार के रहने वाले हैं। इनसे 7 लैपटॉप, 38 स्मार्ट फोन, 25



कोपैड फोन, 2 हार्ड डिस्क, 2 स्मार्ट वॉच, 114 सिम कार्ड और एयरटेल का एक डॉंगल बरामद किया गया है। इसके अलावा 25 बैंक खातों और घोखाघड़ी में इस्तेमाल चार वॉलट को फ्रीज

बुकिंग के नाम पर उसके साथ 30,998 रुपये की ठगी हुई है। साइबर पुलिस ने जांच शुरू की टैक्नीकल सर्विलांस की मदद लेते हुए कई शहरों में छापेमारी के बाद आरोपियों को पकड़ लिया गया। ओला इलेक्ट्रिक स्कूटी लेने के इच्छुक लोगों को जाल में फंसाने के लिए आरोपियों ने फर्जी वेबसाइट बनाई हुई थी। इसके बाद बुकिंग राशि और पंजीकरण के नाम पर लोगों से ऑनलाइन मोड से 499 रुपए का भुगतान करवाया गया। ट्रांसपोर्टेशन शुल्क और बीमा आदि के नाम पर भी लोगों से रकम वसूली गई।

नई दिल्ली। शाहदरा जिले की साइबर पुलिस ने गे डेटिंग एप के जरिए एक कॉलेज छात्र से वसूली करने वाले एक रैकेट का पर्दाफाश किया है। ठगों ने पहले छात्र से नजदीकी बढ़ाई और फिर भरोसा जीतने के बाद उसे एक कमरे पर ले गये। इसके बाद उसकी अश्लील वीडियो बना सोशल मीडिया पर वायरल करने की धमकी दी जाने लगी। इस सिलसिले में पुलिस ने चार ठगों को गिरफ्तार किया है। डीसीपी शाहदरा आर सत्यसुंदरम के अनुसार इस संबंध में 12 नवंबर शिकायत मिली थी। शिकायतकर्ता ने बताया कि गे डेटिंग एप ब्लूएड के जरिए एक युवक के संपर्क में आया और उसके साथ वेंटिंग करने लगा। 8 नवंबर को दोनों ने एक दूसरे से मिलना तय किया। दोनों दुर्गापुरी चौक पर डोमिनोस में मिले। फिर वे एक कमरे पर गए। जैसे ही दोनों ने कपड़े उतारे तभी तीन युवक रूम में घुस आए और उनकी वीडियो बनाने लगे। बाद में इसी वीडियो को सोशल मीडिया पर वायरल करने की धमकी देकर उससे पैसे का डिमांड की जाने लगी। नहीं देने पर पीडित के मोबाइल से उन्होंने खुद एक अकाउंट में 12,700 रुपए ट्रांसफर करवा लिए। इसके बाद भी उसे ब्लैकमेल कर रुपयों की मांग की गई थी। जब डिमांड पूरी नहीं हुई तो वे उसकी स्कूटी और मोबाइल को लूट कर फरार हो गए।

एक लाख का इनामी अंडमान एंड निकोबार पुलिस का वांटेड क्राइम ब्रांच ने दबोचा रेप केस में मुख्य सचिव पहले हो चुका है अरेस्ट

क्राइम ब्रांच की दक्षिणी रेंज ने अंडमान निकोबार पुलिस के रेप केस के वांटेड को करनाल से अरेस्ट किया है। इसकी गिरफ्तारी पर एक लाख रुपये का इनाम भी घोषित किया जा चुका था। आरोपी का नाम संदीप सिंह उर्फ रिंकू (38) निवासी डालमिया और केडिया सिटी, मिनी बे, पोर्ट ब्लेयर, अंडमान और निकोबार द्वीप है। इस मामले में तत्कालीन मुख्य सचिव पहले अरेस्ट किया जा चुका है। स्पेशल सीपी रविंद्र सिंह यादव के अनुसार इसी साल 1 अक्टूबर को अंडमान और निकोबार के पुलिस स्टेशन एवरडोन में यौन उत्पीड़न का मामला दर्ज किया गया था। तत्कालीन मुख्य सचिव जितेंद्र नारायण और उनके अन्य सहयोगियों संदीप उर्फ रिंकू (होटल मालिक) और अंडमान के तत्कालीन श्रम आयुक्त ऋषि पर आरोप लगाए गए थे। मामले में तत्कालीन

मुख्य सचिव जितेंद्र नारायण को अंडमान और निकोबार पुलिस पहले ही गिरफ्तार कर चुकी है। अंडमान और निकोबार पुलिस ने संदीप और ऋषि तत्कालीन श्रमायुक्त की गिरफ्तारी पर एक लाख रुपये का इनाम घोषित किया था। इन फरार आरोपियों की गिरफ्तारी में क्राइम ब्रांच की मदद मांगी गई थी। डीसीपी राजेश देव के नेतृत्व वाली टीम ने हरिद्वार, ऋषिकेश समेत अन्य जगहों पर 100 से ज्यादा होटलों व गेस्ट हाउस में जांच की, लेकिन कोई सुराग नहीं लगा। आगे जानकारी मिली कि आरोपी करनाल में हो सकता है। टीम तुरंत करनाल पहुंची और आखिरकार आरोपी संदीप सिंह को गिरफ्तार कर लिया। उस समय आरोपी भुवनेश्वर, उड़ीसा भागने की कोशिश कर रहा था। आरोपी पोर्ट ब्लेयर के डालीगैंग में देसी लाउंड्रिंग के नाम से होटल चलाता था। उपरोक्त मामला दर्ज होने के बाद से वह कोलकाता, दिल्ली और धारीवाल, पंजाब में छिपकर रह रहा था।

अमानतुल्लाह से जुड़ा मामला एलजी ने दिल्ली वक्फ बोर्ड के पूर्व सीईओ अली की जांच के लिए केंद्र से सिफारिश की

उपराज्यपाल वीके सक्सेना ने कथित गड़बड़ी को लेकर एक्शन लेते हुए दिल्ली वक्फ बोर्ड के पूर्व सीईओ एसएम अली के खिलाफ केंद्र सरकार से जांच की सिफारिश की है। यह मामला वक्फ बोर्ड के अध्यक्ष रहे अमानतुल्लाह खान से जुड़ा हुआ है। सूत्रों के अनुसार दिल्ली बोर्ड के सीईओ रहे आईएस अधिकारी एसएम अली पर आरोप है कि उन्होंने बोर्ड के तत्कालीन अध्यक्ष अमानतुल्लाह खान के गलत प्रस्ताव को पारित करवाने में अहम भूमिका निभाई। सूत्रों का कहना है कि केंद्रीय सतकेता विभाग (सीबीआई) इस मामले में कार्रवाई कर रही है, जिसमें सामने आया कि तत्कालीन अध्यक्ष अमानतुल्ला खान के आदेश पर अवैध प्रस्तावों को मंजूरी दिए गई थी। इसके बाद उपराज्यपाल सक्सेना ने केंद्र सरकार से इस मामले में कार्रवाई करने की सिफारिश भेजी है। वहीं इस मामले में भ्रष्टाचार निरोधक शाखा (एसीबी) भी अमानतुल्लाह खान पर लगे भ्रष्टाचार के आरोपों को बेहद गंभीर मान रही है। राजनिवास से जुड़े सूत्रों की मानें तो बोर्ड के अध्यक्ष रहते अमानतुल्लाह खान कथित तौर पर कई अनियमितताओं में शामिल थे।
